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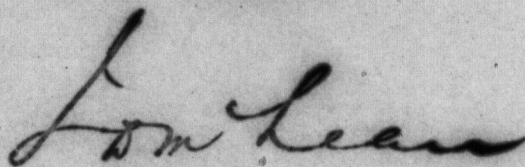
Ottawa, February 29, 1908.

Sir,-

I have to inform you that Peter Wankey has requested the Department to permit him to sell timber to the value of \$100.00, to be cut in the cull bush, for the purpose of paying Messrs. Johnston, Hunter & Crawford, of Wlaxton, for balance due on a team.

The Department is not in favour of allowing Indians to barter timber for horses, but if the Band approves of the application, and if you are prepared to recommend that a permit be given him in this instance, on receipt of a full report from you the matter will be further considered, and in the meantime you may tell Wankey that his letter has been received.
