
Ottawa, April 7, 1909.

Sir,-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your communication of the 29th ultimo, in regard to the land applied for on the Long Lake Indian Reserve, and in reply to say that, in connection with the roadway across this property, a communication has recently been received from Mr. Superintendent Vowell, in which he states that the roadway was gasetted, but that the Hon. the Minister of Public Works has under consideration the advisability of cancelling this roadway and having another survey made for a new location.

It would appear desirable, before issue of grant in this case, to have the question of roadway definitely decided, and I have to ask you to kindly take the matter up with Mr. Superintendent Vowell and furnish the Department with a correct description by metes and bounds of the road to be reserved.
