I have to request you to be good enough to inform me as soon as you conveniently can whether there is any valid objection to this exchange and if the exchange is not sufficient in value, what further sum should be demanded from the Railway Company.

The Right of Way Agent of the Company desires that you shall meet their Agent, Mr. Bateman, on the ground. He will probably be advised through the Company to communicate with you with a view of arranging a meeting.
