



Ottawa, 3rd March, 1916.

Sir:-

Referring to your letter of the 14th ultimo, and the voucher for \$12.00 which you submitted for wood for destitute Indians of your Agency, I beg to say that you should endeavour to get the Indians of your Agency to make provision during the summer for their requirements in the way of fuel during the winter months, as the Department does not propose to pay for wood for Indians who reside in a country where there is a plentiful supply of fuel. The young Indians should provide fuel for the aged and you should see that this is done at the proper time of the year.
