
Ottawa, October 22nd, 1919.

Reverend Sir,-

The September quarter grant of the St. Brune Boarding school is being paid on an average attendance of 50 pupils and amounts to \$1612.50. From this amount a deduction of \$60.00, for supplies purchased by the school from the Militia Department, is being made and a cheque for the balance, - \$1752.50, is being sent you.

The grant for the Wabiscow Lake R.C. Boarding school is being paid on an average attendance of 14.61 and amounts to \$556.86. This school also purchased supplies from the Militia Department to the amount of \$60.00, which amount is being deducted from the grant and a cheque for the balance, \$473.86, is being sent you.
