



Ottawa, 17th November, 1919.

Sir,-

I beg to refer to vouchers Nos. 593 and 664 in favour of the Regina Gray Nun's Hospital forwarded to the Department by Mr. Stanton on the 31st May and 16th October, 1918, for hospital treatment of destitute Indians, and to request that you will report whether voucher No. 664 is for treatment of Baby Louisa Lowe. You should also state whether the credit of \$15.00 in voucher No. 664 represents cash paid by Mrs. Lowe and covers the treatment from April 27th to May 6th. If such is the case it would appear that a double payment of \$15.00 was made.
