of \$1.2 million, and to Nova Scotia growers to the extent of 25 cents per bushel (75 cents per barrel) on approximately 1.2 million bushels of graded apples, at a cost of \$300,000, the Department of Agriculture to pay these sums to British Columbia Tree Fruits Limited and the Nova Scotia Apple Marketing Board respectively for distribution on an appropriate basis to growers making deliveries to them;

(b) agreed that supplementary estimate would be sought for the purpose during the next regular session of Parliament when it would be indicated that no further assistance would be given to apple growers; and

(c) agreed that, in the meantime, the growers' representatives be informed of the foregoing with clear indication that it was not proposed to grant them any further financial assistance.
