## MINUTES of the 17 th Meeting of the FINANOE COMMITTEE of the Board of Goverhors of the Ganadian Broedcesting Corporation held in <br> Ot tawa on January $30,1941$.

The meeting opened at 10.30 a.m. With Mr. N.L. Nathanson in the Ghair and Mr. Rene Morin present; qladstone Murrey, Auguetin Frigon and W.0. Findlay in attendance. It was learned that Mr. J.W. Goderey would not be present until the afternoon, so it was decided to discuse the business in hand for daoisions on Mr. Godfrey's arrival.
(1) The Finance Statement was discussed in detail and the various items of revenue and expenditure examined. Information before the committee indicated that there would be an eceumulated cash surplus of about $\$ 435,000$ at the end of the fiscad, year, This was considered minimum.

In disoussing next year's financing, the management was instructed to base the budget on the 1940-41 estimated ine ome and to provide for all essential capital oxpendituro from current revenue. It was agreed that there should be also a surplus of $\$ 100,000$ and contingency of $\$ 50,000$ provided for out of eurrent revenue for the fiscal year 1941-42.
(2) The reports of the Chief News gditor and the supervisor of Station Relations in connection with the news service were read. Consideration was given partieularly to the difficulties about news distribution on privately owned stations in Toronto and the rivalry between the newspapers in this connection. It was suggested that the General Manager should explore the matter and endeavour to ascertain from the newspapers what they desired under ideal conditions, after which all those concerned might be assembled In order to work out an equitable solution. A report on the matter should be brought forward at the next meeting.
(3) The Aesistant General Manager reported that a site had been obtained for the now enlarged station GBY on the Dundas
