TRANSPORT - RECORDS

- This office is in receipt of correspondence from a Mr. H.B. Somerville, 58 Samuel Road, Hamilton, Ontario, to the effect that he and a Mr. David Brewer of that city purchased the marginally noted aircraft in August, 1955, and that the aircraft has long since been permanently withdrawn from use.
- Mr. Somerville has stated that his partner, Mr. Brewer, removed the log books and the Certificates of Registration and Airworthiness from the aircraft about two years ago and that he has not heard from Mr. Brewer in over a year as he has left the city of Hamilton. The aircraft is presently sitting in a dilapidated condition at the Sky Harbour Airport, Goderich, Ontario.
- In view of the foregoing it is recommended that this aircraft be deleted from the Canadian Civil Aircraft Register.
