I, James Walkey, was on my farm the afternoon of August 3 approximately 3:30 o'clock which is about \(\frac{1}{2} \) mile east of the scene of the accident. I raise turkeys and heard a disturbance among them and I looked up and saw a glider flying west over the field at about 60 feet altitude. I watched him and he continued in the same direction until he passed out of sight behind some trees and then it was only a matter of 10 or 15 seconds until I heard the crash.

- Q. Did he appear to be in difficulty?
- A. No, wings were level, no dipping or diving.
- Q. Did you see him make a turn?
- A. No.
- Q. Was there a strong wind?
- A. No, just light breeze.
- Q. Wese there any thunderstorms?
- A. No, a clear sky.
- Q. Did you see any other gliders?
- A. No.
