The Company destroying bodies or trucks shall have its option whether to rebuild or settle for same.

RULE 21—If the Company destroying the car elects to rebuild, either body or trucks, or both, the original plan of construction must be followed, and the original kind and quality of materials used. The rebuilding must be completed within 60 days from the original date of damage or destruction. In such cases no allowance sliall be made for betterments.

RULE 22-The settlement prices for new cars and trucks shall be as follows :

Depreciation due to age shall be estimated at 6 per cent. per annunt, upon the yearly depreciated value of bodies and trucks, provided, however, that allowances for depreciation shall in no case exceed 60 per cent. of the value new.

Refrigerator cars and other freight cars designed for special purposes, not specifically referred to above, shall be settled for at special rates, as may be agreed to by the parties in interest, but the deduction for depreciation due to age shall be on the same basis as for regular freight equipment cars.
