

SYNOPSIS OF RULES

NO TALKING in the Library, except to attendants on Library matters; and then in a subdued tone of voice.

The privileges of the Reading Room and the use of the books and periodicals in the building are free to all, whether residents of the city or not.

Residents of Hamilton, above fourteen, may draw books for home reading, on signing the application card and giving a satisfactory guarantee; or making a deposit, generally of \$2.

Non-residents desiring books for home use, must pay \$3 per annum.

Persons entitled to draw books are furnished with a Borrower's Card, (for which five cents must be paid) and they are held responsible for all books drawn thereon. The card must be produced when a book is taken out, returned or renewed. If this card is lost, five cents must be paid for a new one, (which however will not be issued until after 30 days notice, except in special cases).

Give immediate notice of change of residence.

Books may be ONCE renewed, if not wanted at the Library; but they cannot be renewed until the expiry of the two weeks (*i. e.*, books drawn on Saturday cannot be renewed before the Saturday fortnight following). The book had better be brought to the Library when renewing, as if wanted it cannot be renewed.

Books not in when applied for, may be reserved at Receiving Desk, on payment of five cents each if fiction or juvenile, and one cent in all other classes; and notice will be mailed to applicant as soon as book is available.

Three cents a day must be paid on all books kept over-time, with one cent for each mailed notice.

Fiction and Juvenile books cannot be changed until the fourth day after drawing same. If changed before, five cents must be paid. Books in other classes may be changed the day after drawing same, if desired.

Writing in books is strictly prohibited and all injuries to books must be promptly adjusted.

Readers will please note that the Library attendants are strictly forbidden to use their official position to confer upon their friends any advantage in the use of books not accorded to all users of the Library.

The rules in full are posted in the Library, and readers may save themselves possible annoyance and expense by observing same carefully.
