NEW ZEALAND.

The Premier has introduced an amending bill, making the act far more strict than before. One of its clauses provides that, all trade unions in an industrial district shall come under the award, whether industrial unions or not.

Another measure that will, in all probability, reach the statute book, is the few Factory bill, consolidating existing acts, but with some very important new points.

There is a minimum wage of 12 cents per hour, no girl or boy to be employed at less wage than \$1.25 per week. The men are to have a 48-hour week; any time after this is to be paid at time and a quarter.

There is a schedule of a few exemptions, such as for fish-curing, jam-making and other intermittent industries where, at certain times of the year long hours have to be worked, while, at other times, the work is partially or wholly ceased.

The importance of this new bill lies in the fact that, hitherto, the Factories Act has only interfered with the hours of women and boys, and to attempt to regulate the working hours for men is a new departure.

With regard to the proposals of the Government to establish a line of mail steamers to San Francisco, the balance of commercial opinion appears to incline unfavorably against the Oceanic Company.

CARE OF THE HORSE.

Rough usage and neglect will never make a hard horse. The colt must be kept growing thriftily from the start if you want a fine horse. Some say that "feed is above breed," but we say the game is lost without a combination of the two.

Do not let the feet of the road or work horses get hard and dry during the dry weather. Avoid hot loofans. Water is best and safest and is natural. If you find a horse holding a wad of hay in the side of his mouth, have his teeth attended to at once. It is a sure sign that they are sharp.—Farm Journal.
