

former place 10 miles, and from the latter 22; and from Milton the County Town 7 miles. The 12 Mile Creek runs through the village, and affords much hydraulic power for driving machinery. This place contains a good flouring mill with three run of stones, a saw mill with turning and planing machinery attached in good working order, a foundry and agricultural implement manufactory, one tannery, a wagon shop where 5 to 6 hands are employed, a blacksmith shop, two shoemakers, one cabinet shop, a saddle and harness maker, one tailorshop, an hotel, three stores, a post office, one Wesleyan Methodist Church, and a school house. There is a lodge of British American Order of Good Templars. Like some of the noted cities of the Dominion, the village is divided into upper and lower towns, and contains about 160 population.
