Any even numbered section of Dominies Lands in Manitoba er .he North-West Territaries, excepting 5 and 23, which has not been home-steaded, or reserved to portide wood lots for settlers, or for other purposes, may be homewaaded upon by any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 15 years of age, to the extent of one quarter section, of 160 acres ar lean. Entry may be made personally at the local land office for the district in which the land to be taken is aitname, see if the homestender desires, he may, on application to the Minister of the interior, Ottawa, the Con-missioner of immigration, Winnipeg, or the local agent for the district in which the land is given a suthority for some one to make entry for him. A fee of \$10,000 is charged for a homestead entry.

(4) If the settler has his permanent residence upon farming land owned by him in the vicinity of his homestead, the requirements of this Act as to residence may be sufficiently be residence upon the said land. The term "vicinity" used above is meant to indicate the same town, township or an adjoining or cornering township.

A settler who avails binner of the provisions of Clauses (2), (3) or (4) must culture 30 acres of bis homestend, or substitute 20 bead of stock, with buildings for their accommodation, and have besides 80 acres substantially ferced.

The privilege of a second entry is restricted by law to those settlers only who completed the durks upon their first homesteads to entitle them to patent on or before the 2nd June, 1888.

Every housestead or merors the zun June, 1888. Every housestead ar who fails to comply with the requirements of the homestead law is liable to are his entry cancelled, and the land may be again thrown open for entry. APPLICATION FOR PATENT

should be mc is at the send of three years, before the Local Agent, Sub-Agent, or the Homestead respector. Before making application for patent, the settler must give six months notice in writing to the Com-missioner of Dominion Lands, at Ottawa, of his intention to d^{σ} so.
