Synopsis of Canadian North-West Land Regulations

THE sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter-section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. 'Applicant must appear a person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the District.' Entry by proxy may be made at any Dominion Lands Agency (but not: Sub-Agency), on certain conditions.

Duties-Six months residence upon and cul-civation of the land in each of three years. A momesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres, on certain conditions. A habitable honse is required emcept where residence is performed in the wichnity. vicinity.

In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter-section along-elde his homestead. Price \$3.00 per acre.

Dittes-Six months residence in each of three gears after earning homestead patent; also 50 acres extra cultivation. Pre-emption patent may be obtained as soon as homestead patent, on certain conditions.


A settler who has exhausted his homestead right may take a purchased homestead in certain districts. Frice \$3.00 per acre. Duties—Must readide six months in each of three years, cultivate **60 acres and erect** a house worth \$300.

The area of cultivation is subject to reduction in case of rough, scrubby or stony land. Live stock may be substituted for cultivation under certain conditions.




