

- Richmond And a further sum of 420*l.* for the several Roads and Bridges in the County of Richmond, to be applied and expended as aforesaid.
- Cape-Breton And a further sum of 525*l.* at the disposal of His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor or Commander in Chief for the time being, to be expended on the several Roads and Bridges in the County of Cape-Breton.
- Inverness And a further sum of 440*l.* at the disposal of His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor or Commander in Chief for the time being, to be expended on the several Roads and Bridges in the County of Inverness.
- 250*l.* Bridge Sydney River And a further sum of 250*l.* for building a Bridge over the South West Arm of Sydney River.
- 62*l.* 15*s.* 6*d.* survey of Road in Hants And a further sum 62*l.* 15*s.* 6*d.* at the disposal of His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, to enable him to defray the expense of the survey and exploring the line of Road from the New Avon Bridge near Windsor, to Mud Bridge at Wolfville, in Horton, pursuant to His Excellency's recommendation.
- 300*l.* repair of Western Road And a further sum of 300*l.* at the disposal of His Excellency, to pay that amount expended for the repair and improvement of the Great Western Road between Halifax and Windsor, under the Resolution of this House during the last Session.
- 100*l.* Wilmot Breakwater And a further sum of 100*l.* to the Inhabitants of Wilmot, to assist them in building a Breakwater on the shore of Gate's Mountain, which sum of 100*l.* shall be paid out of the Treasury when the Commissioners for the erection of said Breakwater, shall give sufficient evidence of their having expended 150*l.* raised by subscription, for the purpose of building said Breakwater.
- 20*l.* Beacon on Wedge Island And a further sum of 20*l.* in addition to the sum voted last Session, to erect a Beacon on Wedge Island, at the mouth of the Saint Mary's River.
- 220*l.* 8*s.* 5*d.* James Bain & others And a further sum of 220*l.* 8*s.* 5*d.* to James Bain, James N. Shannon and Edward Allison, being the amount of duty paid at the Custom House in Halifax, upon wrecked Goods, afterwards exported to the United States of America, and on which they there paid the duties.
- 26*l.* 18*s.* 2*d.* John Farquhar And a further sum 26*l.* 18*s.* 2*d.* to John Farquhar, being the amount of duties on Goods consumed in his store by Fire.
- 22*l.* 17*s.* Messrs. Cunard & Co. And a further sum of 22*l.* 17*s.* to Messrs. Cunard and Company, for a drawback on Four Puncheons of Rum exported by Benjamin Terrio to Newfoundland.
- 19*l.* 13*s.* J. Leishman And a further sum of 19*l.* 13*s.* to Jas. Leishman, being the amount of duties twice paid by him on Goods imported in the first instance in the Ship Eagle.
- 17*s.* 4*s.* 8*d.* Bar Society And a further sum of 17*l.* 4*s.* 8*d.* to the Committee of the Bar Society, in pursuance of the prayer of their Petition and the report of the Committee thereon.
