PRAYERS.

A Message from the Council.

Mr. Robinson delivered the Message, as follows :---

" Mr. Speaker,

" The Council have agreed to the following nine only of the resolutions of " appropriation sent up by the Assembly, dated 11th March, 1819, to wit,

To His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor or Commander in Chief, the sum of  $\neq 296$ : 10: 4, to defray the expense of making certain Surveys.

To the Clerk of the Council, for defraying the expense of an Assistant-Clerkduring the present Session, the sum of  $\neq 25$ .

To John Head, Esquire, Surgeon, in St. John, the sum of £25.

To Mary Pomroy, the sum of 225.

To the Trustees of the National School, at Kingston, the sum of £60.

To His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, the sum of  $\neq 50$ , for the encouragement of the Free School now established in Fredericton.

To Commissioners to be appointed by His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, the sum of #100, to purchase Potatoes and other seed, the ensuing spring, for the relief of Settlers of the late 104th, New-Brunswick, and 98th Regiments, located upon the river Saint John, between Presqu' Isle and the Great Falls.

To Thomas Wyer, Jun. the sum of  $\pounds 178: 1: 2$ , to repay the amount advanced by him to replace the Buckabeck bridge.

To Moses Vernon, the sum of  $\neq 52:15:6$ , to repay that amount advanced by him to repair the bridges on the two new rivers, and for other disbursements, as one of the Supervisors for the road from St. John to St. Andrew's.

And then Mr. Robinson withdrew.

Mr. Smith, by leave, brought in a Bill, " to provide for opening and im-" proving Roads and erecting Bridges throughout the Province."

Which was read a first and second time. The optimized and a superior of the optimized and the further consideration thereof be postponed ofor three months.

The House then adjourned until to-morrow morning, at eleven o'clock.
