Mr. Goff, Chairman of the Committee appointed to manage the free conference with a Committee of his Majefty's Council, on the fubject matter of the Bill intituled, "An Act for the further increase of the Revenue, by tailing a Duty of "Impolt on all Goods, Wares, and Merchándize, imported into this Colony, "except as are herein after excepted, for the purpose of erecting Gaols in this "Colony, and for fuch other purposes as are therein mentioned," reported that the Committee of this House met the Committee of his Majesty's Council, who suggested feveral alterations, to the faid Bill, and the Chairman reported the Heads of the faid alterations to the House.

On Motion of Mr. M<sup>e</sup>Neill, feconded by Mr. Goff; The Houfe refolved itfelf into a Committee of the whole Houfe, to take into confideration, the faid Report, (Mr. Goff; in the Chair,) and after fome time fpent therein, the Speaker refumed the Chair, and Chairman reported, that the Committee had agreed to certain amendments proposed to the aforefaid Bill.

A Meffage from His Majefty's Council, by their Clerk,

Mr. Speaker,—His Majefty's Council have agreed to the Bill intituled, "An "Act for repealing certain parts of an Act made and passed in the Fourteenth "Year of his prefent Majefty's Reign, intituled an Act for regulating the mea-"fure of Boards and all other kinds, of Lumber, and for appointing Officers "to survey fame, and for declaring what shall be deemed Merchantable Tim-"ber for exportation," without any amendment.
