### Rufus Casey Instantly Killed

Rufus Casey, a merchant of Mosherville, Hants, was instantly killed while on his way home from Halifax. Mr. Casey, who was about 50 years old and married, was in Halifax on Thursday making purchases. He left in the afternoon D.A. R. train, got off at Windsor and took the Midland railway for Mosherville. After reaching there he left the train and started to walk down the track to his home, which is about a mile from the station. Just how the accident happened, no one knows, but about 8 o'clock the body of a badly mangled man was found in the middle of the track about midway between the station and Mr. Casey's house. The remains were identified by papers in his pockets.

### Chas Feener Drowned at Lunenburg

Lunenburg, June 5—The schooner Ada M. Westhaver arrived from the Banks yesterday with a fine trip of fish, but the success of the trip has been greatly marred by the loss of Charles Feener, one of the crew. The vessel was on the outside of Battery Point, and landing fish to the Weizner Stage when a short distance from the shore a sea struck the dory, sinking her immediately and carrying its only inmate to the bottom with it.

A dory was sent in haste from the schooner, and when the body of young Feener was recovered life was extinct. The deceased was 23 years of age, an adopted son of Edward Feener, Centre Range. An inquest will be held by Coroner Forbes, and the body interred at First South. This is the first trip of Capt. William Mason as skipper, and he feels the loss of this member of his crew most keenly. At the point where the accident took place the shore is bad, and today the sea was quite choppy.

### The Queen Mary Fought Entire Hun Navy Single Handed

London, June 5—An Edinburgh despatch to the Times says:

"Men say the Hindenburg is at the bottom of the sea. Bombs from above were a constant peril to our ships. The Queen Mary is said to have been hit by one, but the great ship went down as befitted her rank with the fire of the enemy concentrated upon her. She was first into the fight, and for five minutes, in the words of every witness, took on the whole German navy by herself." The invincible too, made a wonderful sight. ### At Right Time The British Will Astonish World

New York, June 2—A cable to the New York Times from Paris says:

"Premier Briand's ready acceptance in principle of a secret session—whereof the mere threat was sufficient to overthrow Viviani—has taken the wind from his opponents' sails. It is probable that if a secret session is held it will be devoid of sensation, as in England."

"The position of the Cabinet is greatly strengthened, but intrigues continue, especially by certain groups directing attacks against those responsible for the prosecution of military operations, with a view to discrediting the Government indirectly."

"I am charged by a very high authority to deny one of their favorite suggestions, namely, that there is lack of co-operation between the French and British general staffs. On the contrary, it is with the French staff's accord that the British methodically continue preparations and decline to be hurried into action before the psychological moment. The authority characterizes as a shameful lie the allegation that the British are indifferent to French sacrifices at Verdun, and says the difficulty has been to restrain the British until the appointed time."

"When the day comes—it is, perhaps, not far distant—the critics will be silenced and the rest of the world astonished."
