THE BOTTOM OF THE SEA. THE GREAT PRESSURE SUSTAINED BY DEEP WATER FISHES. A Novel Experiment in Mid-Ocean—Fish Life in the Deep Waters Not Without Danger—Some Peculiarly Interesting Physical Conditions.
