ABOUT A CIRCULAR

Issued by Ex-commissioner Quinn
to the Electors

Why the Circular was not Justified—
A Letter From the Author of It.

Ex-Water Commissioner Fred F. Quinn has issued a circular stating that he may support his partner, Ald. George Stephens, in preference to Mayor Smith. Now, there can be no fault found with Mr. Quinn for giving a candidate, with whom he has been so closely associated in a business way, his support. But, we think Mr. Quinn in leaving the local Conservative party in this election rather shows ingratitude. He gives as an excuse for his course in his circular that he has been influenced by "The unsuspicious tactics of The Planet, T. A. Smith or his supporters." Mr. Quinn's letter, published below, generates The Planet in everything, except the pork factory matter, yet there is no question before the electors less open to dispute. Mayor Smith introduced a pork factory scheme. Ald. Stephens, as chairman of finance, recommended that it be thrown out. This was done. There are the facts. They are on the municipal records. The Planet has stated them from the first. If there are apologies or excuses to be made for Ald. Stephens' course, it is not The Planet's business to make them. It is not Ald. Stephens' advocate or his excuser. That is what his own organ is for. So, as far as this journal has influenced Mr. Quinn's conduct, he has been hard put to find an excuse when he can only bring up the pork factory matter.

Now, let us take his reference to Mayor Smith. It is a notorious fact that from the first Mayor Smith has been most venomously attacked, not on the public platform but behind his back. First he was slandered on financial grounds. It was attempted to be made a crime in the eyes of the electors that Mayor Smith had not succeeded in making as much money as Ald. Stephens. This argument was not used by irresponsible members of the Liberal party, but by men whose standing and position should have placed them above such contemptible tactics.

But even to lie about a man financially was not sufficient. He had to be attacked in a more underhand and disreputable manner still. The race and religious cry had to be raised. A carpet-bagger had to be imported to ground and whisper falsehoods into the ears of the Roman Catholics. In fact every contemptible device was resorted to to injure Mr. Stephens' opponent. Then, because Mr. Smith saw fit to try and defend himself against one of the dirtiest personal campaigns ever carried on in Canada, Mr. Quinn gives that as his other excuse for interfering on behalf of Ald. Stephens in this election.

All this looks to The Planet as if Mr. Quinn were simply anxious to leave his old friends in the present confusion, and was hard pressed to find some reason, good or bad, for siding. Now, as we said at first, he has a perfect right to support whom he pleases, but surely he could for this election—have left the old ship—which has done good service in carrying him through the storms of the past—without giving it an unnecessary kick.

Mr. Quinn says in his letter that he is still a supporter of the general Conservative policy, but that friendship for Ald. Stephens has led him to act as he has done towards his old political friends. We are pleased to learn that Mr. Quinn is still in accord with Sir Charles Tupper. Had he simply withdrawn his support from Mr. Smith on account of his friendship for Mr. Stephens no one could have found fault. It is not his action, but the manner in which he took it that we have to complain of.

MR. QUINN'S LETTER.

Proprietor Planet, City:

Dear Sir,—Replying to your enquiry as to my position as a Conservative and just how far I blame The Planet in circulating reports in connection with George Stephens, I would like to say that I was and am still favorable to the Conservative party. I have had no cause to blame your paper for the reports circulated in reference to the Rankin shooting affair or my conversation in reference to same with Mr. Stephens, but I certainly do blame your paper for so persistently keeping before the public the matter of the pork packing factory, as I know that you must be aware that George Stephens in this respect is not as much to blame as was T. A. Smith. T. A. Smith, by virtue of his office as mayor, is a member of any committee, and if the unanimous report of the finance committee as presented to the council, in respect to the pork packing factory, was not a right and proper thing, then T. A. Smith could have easily so expressed himself and at that time had it rectified if it was wrong. There are many other things that have been said about Mr. Stephens that I know are untrue, but which I do not blame your paper for, and for that reason I have taken the stand I have. I am not making this statement to shirk anything said formerly. I am simply doing so that the Conservatives may know that I am not opposed to their policy in general, for I feel that I could not be anything else but a Conservative, but my friendship for Mr. Stephens and my intimate knowledge of his straightforward business tactics and honorable dealing in the

past will not permit me to remain silent when I know that he is being misrepresented.
