It has been learned on good authority that the Goldale will be opened to a depth of 1,000 feet and that arrangements will be made at an early date to commence sinking from the present depth of 500 feet.

Within the next few weeks, the mill on the Argonaut Gold will be set in operation and will handle about fifty tons of ore daily at the beginning.

Operations have been temporarily suspended on the Martin Gold Mines and the mining crew has been paid off.
