

Architects and Chief Commissioner Report on Plans for **Government House.**

Five Out of the Nine Designs Have Been Given a Place.

In response to the notice published by the lands and works department on October 31 last, inviting British Columbia architects to compete, nine sets of designs for the proposed new Government

House were submitted, under the following nom de plume: "Spero," "Volute No. 1," "Volute No. 2," "Domus Con-sulis," "Norma," "Olympian," "Kola," "Paardeberg," and "Three Hundred and **Freight Rates**

"Paardeberg," and "Three Hundred and Thirty-three." Pursuant to the conditions of the com-petition, these designs were critically examined and compared by Messrs. W. Ridgway Wilson and J. C. Keith, non-competing architects, in conjunction with the chief commissioner of lands and works, who have reported that the vari-ous plans represent a large amount of very careful work, and in most cases the general conditions as to style of draughtsmanship and number of draw-ings had been adhered to. 
