Impressive Ceremonies to be Celebrated To-day at Roman Church.

Insignia of High Office to be Laid Upon Prominent Local Dignitary.

At 10:30 this morning there will be a solemn pontifical mass at St. Andrew's Cathedral. His Excellency, the Archbishop of Vancouver, will officiate. At the conclusion of the pontifical mass His Excellency will confer upon Archbishop Orly the insignia of the archiepiscopal dignity. The pallium will be conferred by the late Pope Leo XIII. It is the insignia of the archiepiscopal office. It is a white stole with a gold fringe and a gold cross on the shoulders. It is a symbol of the archbishop's authority.
