

Those who have farms for sale will confer a favor by sending a full description, the price and post office address of owner to the undersigned, in order that the parties inquiring may be brought into personal touch with those who have land to sell.

There will be no charge or commission of any kind, and the parties furnishing descriptions are not bound in any way. Give details as to situation, acreage, roads, improvements, soil, distance from churches, schools, towns, railways, telephone service, etc., that would be of interest to prospective purchasers at a distance. When sale of farm takes place, please notify the secretary so it may be struck off the list. Parties offering large farms, suitable for fruit growing, would do well to offer them in lots of 50 acres. The Publicity Association exists for the purpose of advertising Lambton County, and for no other purpose. It consists largely of the members of the county council, and the expense of the advertising is paid by the county.

FOR HARVESTING IN WESTERN CANADA
\$10 Going Trip \$18 Additional for Return on Following Conditions:
GOING DATES
AUGUST 3rd—From all stations on all lines on and South of the Grand Trunk Main Line, Toronto to Sarnia, including all stations on C.P.R., Toronto to Detroit and Branch Lines including Guelph sub-division from Guelph South and Brampton South.
AUGUST 12th—From all stations North of Grand Trunk Main Line, Toronto to Sarnia, including C.P.R. points, Bolton Jct. and west; also Grand Trunk points, Toronto to Calendar inclusive.

Free transportation will be furnished at Winnipeg to points on Canadian Pacific where laborers are needed, east of Moose Jaw and Saskatoon, including branches, and at one cent a mile each way west thereof in Saskatchewan and Alberta.
A certificate is furnished with each ticket, and this certificate, when executed by farmer showing that laborer has worked thirty days or more, will be honored from that point for a second class ticket back to starting points in Ontario, at \$15.00, prior to Nov. 30th, 1911.
Tickets are good only on special Farm Laborers' trains, which will be run from Toronto and Ontario points to Winnipeg without change, making trip in about 36 hours, and will be issued to women as well as to men, but will not be issued at half fare to children.
