erance, have faced persecutions, seduction and bandon, you have kept everywhere, not only the radition but also the religion, customs, language and love of your country. Has not the time rrived to depart from that selfish indifference with which we rewarded their affection? Those o whom the greatness and prospects of France are yet worthy of consideration will understand that to call attention on the national question to mind the future eventually laid up for the reach race.
