



IN LONDON, ENGLAND, 1886.

FIFTY-FOUR THOUSAND FEET RESERVED FOR CANADA.

First Royal Exhibition Commission since 1862.

THE COLONIAL AND INDIAN EXCIBITION TO BE held in LONDON, England, commencing MAY 1st, 1880 is iptended to be on scale of great magnitude, having for object to mark an epach in the relations of all the parts of the British Empire with each other.

Is order to give becoming significance to the event, a Poyal Commission is lesured for the holding of this Exhibition, for the first time since 1832; and Ills Royal Highness the Prince of Wales has been appointed President by Har Matters.

The ver. large space of 58,000 square feet has been allotted to the Dominion of Canada by command of the President, Ris Royal Highness.

Th's Exhibition is to be purely Colonial and Indian, and no competition from the Uauted Kingdom, or from foreign nations will be permitted, the object belong to exhibit to the world at lurge what the Colonies can do.

The grandest opportunity ever offered to C mada is thus afforded to show the distinguished piace she occupies, by the progress she has made in Acrecutors, in Hornicolvors, in the Industrial and Fire Acre, in the Manufacturing Rousering, in the Navest Improvements in Manufacturing Machiners and Implements, in the Police Works by Models and Designs; also in an adequate display offers vast resources in the Figuraire, and in Forest and Miseral wealth, and also in Supprise.

All Canadians of all parties and classes are invited to come forward and vie with each other in endeavouring on this great occasion to put Canada in her true place as the premier colony of the British Empire, and to establish her proper position before the world.


