

THE GREAT ENO HANDICAP.

York, Aug. 25.—The Great Eno Handicap Stakes of 300 sovereigns, added to a sweepstakes of 20 sovereigns each, 10 forfeit and 5 only if declared; winners of a handicap value 100 sovereigns subsequent to August 4, at 9 a. m., 7 pounds; of two of that value, or one of 200 sovereigns, 10 pounds; of three, or one value 500 sovereigns, 14 pounds extra; the second to receive 50 sovereigns out of the stakes, and third to save his stake. Two miles; 46 subscribers, 18 of whom declared.
