A BRIDE'S CONFESSION

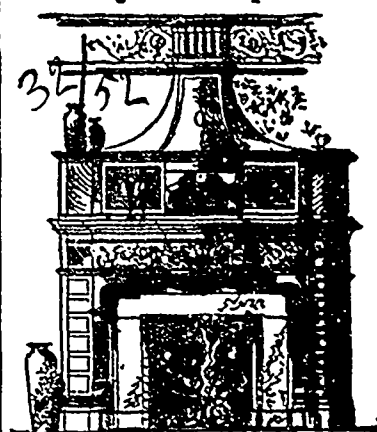

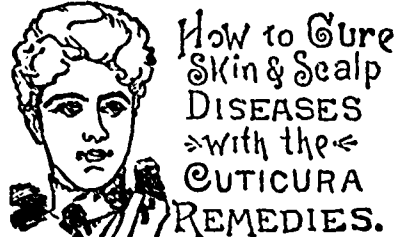

Household Hints.

SOFT water should be used in cooking vegetables, and the only way city folks can soften water is to add a little salt to it. Six or eight potatoes will need a teaspoonful of salt added to the water; turnips and parsnips require about the same, that is, a teaspoonful of salt to a quart of water. If any scum should happen to rise to the surface when the vegetables are boiling, it must be carefully skimmed off.

PAPERED walls are cleaned by being wiped down with a flannel cloth tied over a broom or brush. Then cut off a thick piece of stale bread and rub down with this. Begin at the top and go straight down.

HERE are two things to remember when cooking either veal or pork; they should be cooked so thoroughly that the lean part will be white and firm, and they should never be boiled unless first well salted. With pork there should be served some kind of farinaceous vegetable, like rice, potatoes or hominy.

STEWED VEAL. — Lay a knuckle of veal in a saucepan with two blades of mace, an onion, a small whole pepper and some salt, with two quarts of water; cover it close, and let it simmer for two hours.

To prevent oilcloth, patent leather and similar materials from sticking together when rolled, purchase a few sheets of paraffine-impregnated or otherwise prepared paper, and roll the material. This will prevent sticking. It will also prevent the fading of the colours or gloss by keeping out air and moisture; the evaporation of the oil is likewise prevented to a great extent.

GRIDDLE CAKES. — Three cups flour, three teaspoonfuls Cleveland's Superior Baking Powder, one teaspoonful salt, two beaten eggs and enough milk to make a batter. Bake at once.

APPLE DUMPLING. — One quart of flour, one tablespoonful of lard, two tablespoonfuls of baking powder wet with milk, roll out an inch thick, and place on it eight apples, sliced thin; put in pudding bag and boil one hour.

OATMEAL COOKIES. — One cupful of sugar, two eggs, one cupful of flour, one cupful of cold boiled oatmeal, one teaspoonful of soda, two teaspoonfuls of cream tartar, one tablespoonful of butter; roll thin, and bake in a quick oven.

HOW TO USE SOAP BARK. — Get five cents worth of soap bark, put it in a bowl of water and let stand overnight; strain carefully, add to it three quarts of water and wash the article in it; it needs no rinsing.

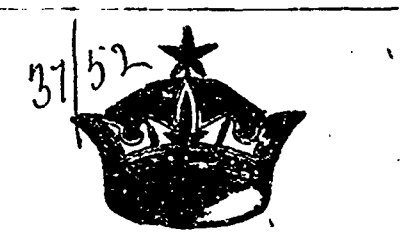
