

- More than 200 Canadian companies have established a direct presence in Australia through investment, joint ventures, sales offices or licensing agreements. The compatible sizes and levels of technology of the two economies have contributed to the formation of technology transfers and joint ventures. Canadian firms with Australian operations include Northern Telecom Canada Ltd., TD Bank, T.C. Moore Transport (Canada) Ltd., Placer Dome Canada Ltd., Norcen Energy Resources Ltd., and McCain Foods Ltd.
- During the Prime Minister's visit to Australia in 1995, Canada and Australia signed a trade and economic co-operation arrangement to facilitate co-operation on multilateral, regional and bilateral trade policy issues and on business development, with an emphasis on small and medium enterprises.
