HIS EXCELLENCY MR. JOHN KNOX PRESENTED TODAY TO THE DEPUTY GOVERNOR-GENERAL, THE HONOURABLE PATRICK KERWIN, P.C. CHIEF JUSTICE OF CANADA, HIS LETTERS OF CREDENCE AS AMBASSADOR EXTRAORDINARY AND PLENIPOTENTIARY OF DENMARK TO CANADA.

MR. JULES LEGER, UNDER-SECRETARY OF STATE FOR EXTERNAL AFFAIRS, WAS IN ATTENDANCE ON THE DEPUTY GOVERNOR-GENERAL ON THIS OCCASION. THE CHIEF OF PROTOCOL, MR. MCCORDICK, PRESENTED THE AMBASSADOR TO THE DEPUTY GOVERNOR-GENERAL. THE AMBASSADOR WAS ACCOMPANIED BY MR. SVEND BUNCH, SECRETARY OF THE EMBASSY.

MR. KNOX IS A GRADUATE OF LAW. HE HAS HELD THE POSTS OF COUNSELLOR AT THE DANISH MILITARY MISSION IN BERLIN AND LATER AT THE DANISH EMBASSY IN BONN. MR. KNOX PRIOR TO HIS APPOINTMENT AS DANISH AMBASSADOR TO CANADA, WAS ASSISTANT UNDER-SECRETARY OF STATE OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF DENMARK. HE WAS DENMARK'S PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE TO THE EUROPEAN COUNCIL AND LAST YEAR HE ACTED AS DEPUTY TO THE PERMANENT DANISH DELEGATE TO UNITED NATIONS.

MR. KNOX IS KNIGHT OF THE ORDER OF DANNEBORG AND DECORATED WITH THE SILVER CROSS OF THE SAME ORDER.
