Manuchehr Agah, 44, is a professor of Economics at Tehran University. Born in Rafsanjan, Iran, he obtained his doctorate in Economics at Oxford University, after having received a master's degree in Economics and Political Science at Cambridge University. Since 1954, he has been a member of several United Nations committees of experts and, between 1965 and 1968, was with the International Monetary Fund. Mr. Agah was President of the Society for International Development in Tehran from 1970 to 1972. In 1973-74, Mr. Agah was Deputy Minister of Finance for the Department of Economic Affairs and Finance of Iran.
