PRAYERS.

Mr. Speaker, from the Special Committee on House Procedure, presented the First Report of the said Committee which is as follows:—

The Special Committee appointed on April 7, 1952 to consider with Mr. Speaker the procedure of this House begs leave to present its First Report.

PART I

Your Committee recommends the following changes in the Standing Orders of the House of Commons:

1. That Standing Order 2 be amended by striking out the words "3 o'clock" and substituting the words "2.30 o'clock" in the first paragraph thereof.
2. That Standing Order 7 be amended by striking out the words "At eleven" and substituting the words "At ten" in the first line thereof.
3. That Standing Order 15 be amended:
 - (a) by striking out the words "(From eight to nine o'clock p.m.)" appearing under the headings "Tuesday (Government Day)" and "Friday (Government Day)", in paragraph (3) and substituting therefor the words "(From five to six o'clock p.m.)" in both instances.
 - (b) by striking out the words "9 o'clock" in paragraph (4) and substituting therefor the words "6 o'clock".
