PRAYERS.

Mr. Harris, by leave of the House, introduced a Bill, No. 238, An Act to amend The United Kingdom Financial Agreement Act, 1946, which was read the first time and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.

The following Bill from the Senate was read the first time and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House:

Bill No. 226 (Letter E of the Senate), intituled: "An Act to amend the Royal Canadian Mounted Police Act".—*Mr. Garson.*

On motion of Mr. Zaplitny, seconded by Mr. McCullough (Moose Mountain), it was ordered,—That an humble Address be presented to His Excellency the Governor General praying that he will cause to be laid before this House a copy of all correspondence, telegrams and/or other communications exchanged between the government and farm organizations and/or commercial firms with regard to cash advances on farm stored grain and/or the Prairie Grain Producers Interim Financing Act, since January 1st, 1957. The Order being read for the House in Committee on Bill No. 15 (Letter I of the Senate), intituled: "An Act respecting Trans Mountain Oil Pipe Line Company";

Mr. Knowles raised a point of order to the effect that the order for the consideration in Committee of the Whole of this Bill, An Act respecting Trans Mountain Oil Pipe Line Company, should stand until the printed evidence of
