FILMING OF FORT LATOUR EXCAVATIONS, N.B.

Questions

Question No. 26-Mr. Bell:

1. Has the National Film Board and/or the C.B.C. received a request from the Municipality of Saint John, New Brunswick, to film or televise the Fort Latour excavations?

2. If so, will a program, based on the history of the historic site from the Red Paint Indian, French and English settlements, to the Loyalist occupations of Saint John be produced?

3. Will this matter be investigated and discussed in detail with the mentioned municipal group?

Hon. Maurice Lamontagne (Secretary of State): I am informed by the National Film Board and the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation as follows:

1. Yes, representations have been made to the National Film Board on behalf of the municipality of Saint John.

2. While the Board does not at this time contemplate a separate film on the history of this site as described in question 2, consideration will be given to this topic in a broader film concerning the history of Acadia.

3. Yes, the municipal group mentioned will be included among those people contacted at the research stage of the proposed film on the history of Acadia.

1. The defence of Fort Latour was one of a number of suggestions received as a program of historic interest.

2. It will be considered along with other suggestions for special Centennial programming and a decision reached in due course.

3. Yes, if it is decided to use it as a television program.
