

WORM, *n.* 1st. Gamálteni.

2d. Worms of wood, Sguaiálko.

3d. Worms of dry meat or salmon, Chechfú.

4th. Gun worm, Chgólkomen.

5th. Spiral, Es-iluéis.

WORM, *v. t.* To wind it as spun yarn, a coil, Ies-chialmin, Ies-chializem.

WORM-EATEN, *a.* Chin-gamálteni.

WORN-OUT, *a.* 1st. Consumed by wear and tear, Temuálsh.

2d. Of ropes, clothes torn, Łikat.

3d. A person worn out by fatigue, Chin-áigot.

4th. By age, Chin-aámt, Chin-z'sip, Chin-hói.

5th. That can go no further, Chin-nłapáks.

6th. Worn out field, Áigot.

WORSHIP, *v. t.* Ies-póteem, Ies-heëm, Ies-cháum.

WORST, *a. superl.* Łu téie, Łu mił téie, Tel esiá n téie. The worst of all, Es-nshiizin téie.

WORST, *v. t.* See Beat, Gain, Defeat, Win.

WORTH, *n.* 1st. See Price, Value.

2d. Moral worth, Siopiéut, Niopiéuten. See Ió.

WORTH, *a.* 1st. Equal in value to....., Es-nagaláksem l.....

2d. See Deserve.

WORTHLESS, *a.* I-tenemús, Tas néistem.

WORTHY, *a.* 1st. excellent, virtuous, Iopiéut. In composition, S'mi-, S'mis-, S'mil—. You are a worthy man, "Ku-s'mis-kaltemigu." See Seme S'mi, Powerful.

2d. Worthy of, well suited, well qualified for, I-pótu shéi. I am not worthy that you should come in to see me, "Tam i-pótu chin-shéi łu koks-chnólgumentgu."

3d. Worthy of hatred, etc., rendered by affixing —snug to the verb. He is worthy of hatred, "Chemchemsnúg." It deserves my hatred, "I-s'chemchemsnúg." I deserve to be hated, "Chin-chemchemsnúg." I think it worthy of hatred, "Chemchem-
