



Fraser River Railway and Traffic Bridge—1781 feet from shore to shore; width, 19 feet; length of draw, 350 feet; traffic roadway, 26 feet above railway; cost, \$1,000,000. This gives admission from the south to one of the great transcontinental lines—the Great Northern Railway; and it is expected that at an early date the Northern Pacific and other railways from the south will make use of the same highway to reach the business end of B. C.
