a firm Resolution to send him powerful Assistance, when the King of Prussia was meditating an Irruption into Saxony, are well known. All the World is witness of the Effects of her Imperial Majesty of Russia's Declarations; and the Check they gave to the Projects of that Prince, who, to do him Justice, doth not want Discernment and Insight into Men or Things, is some Sort of Proof of the Seriousness of her Intentions, even to those who have not had any Opportunity of being informed of the Transactions of the Cabinet at that Time.

The vigorous Measures which the King of Prussia saw the Czarina ready to enter on, disconcerted his Schemes, tied up his Hands, and rendered for some Time the Man, who was one of the principal Causes and Support of the Disturbances of this Part of the World, as a mere Cypher in the Affairs of Europe: At this Time at this critical Time, who of all People in the World should find the Means to extricate his Prussian Majesty out of these Difficulties; and by a pressing * Sollicitation at the Court of Petersbourg set him at Liberty to pursue Views so satal to the Cause which we make Profession to espouse. No one surely can suspect those very People,

meant; I will quote Part of the Treaty of Warfaav concluded this Year, January the 8th; wherein it is said, "That if in Consequence of his Polish Majesty the Elector of Saxony's Engagements by the present Alliance, his States in Germany should be attack'd, besides the effective Assistance the Allies would give for his immediate Desence; they would use their utmost Efforts to procure him from the Aggressor sull Satisfaction for the Damage he may thereby suitain; and for this Purpose, in Case any of the Countries should be seized on, they shall not lay down their Arms untill the same be fully restored to him. Art. 7th." This is a full Proof of our friendly Disposition towards his Polish Majesty: Which will sarther appear, whenever the Letters, which in this Year passed between the Courts of Petersbourg and London come to light.
