

B. Wade, M.P., for Annapolis County, and a recognized authority in rallway matters. Mr. Wade expects to see another rallway from the west enter Halifax at an early date and adds that 600 miles of new road will be under construction in his province next year. The member for Annapolis, who belongs to the tariff for revenue wing of the Liberal party, is opposed to extending the government rallway system to the Northwest and Pacific Ocean.
