

with a leader of its own, Hon. Nelson Parliament, speaker, has refused to recognize H. H. Dewart as sole leader of the Opposition, and has given as his decision that Messrs. Dewart and Ferguson are equally leaders.

Thus arises the question, to whom the salary voted last session for the leader of the Opposition will be paid. The statute reads that "the sum of \$5.000 shall be payable to that member of the House recognized by the Speaker as leader of the Opposition." Whether, under the ruling now given by the Speaker, the salary should be divided between the Liberal and Conservative leaders, remains a matter of conjecture, and an amendment to the statute will probably be required in order to settle the problem.
