ENGLISH TRIAL FOR IRISH PRISONERS. Sinn Fein Organ Cites Action of U.S., in 1775, as Parallel.

Dublin, Aug. 25.—Young Ireland, organ of the Sinn Fein, will announce in this week's issue that the Dublin Castle authorities after consultation with the premier's office in London, have decided that Irish political prisoners are to be taken to England and tried before an English judge and an English jury.

POLES HAVE EFFECTED COMPLETE DESTRUCTION OF BOLSHEVIK ARMIES. Of Host Which Swept Down on Warsaw Only 30,000 Fugitives Remain—Industries Cannot Replace Equipment Lost Even if Men Are Found.

Paris, Aug. 25.—The destruction of the Bolshevik armies now may be considered complete, according to advices received here. Of the host which swept down on Warsaw nothing is left but 30,000 fugitives. The Poles have taken 80,000 prisoners thus far; but what is more important they have captured great quantities of guns and materials.
