

NOV. 5TH.—SPECIAL MEETING.—A grant of \$150 was made to Glace Bay Mission.

The Bishop stated the object of the present Special Meeting, viz.: to represent the difficulty in which he is placed by the refusal of the Church Endowment Committee to continue the payment for grants to fill the vacancies on the S. P. G. list to places.

The action of the Block Sum Committee was reported relative to the above, viz.: "Inasmuch as the S.P.G. has given two lists, one containing the names of certain clergymen who are to receive salaries during their life time, and the other containing the names of places to which certain specified grants were made, and the "Block Sum" has been granted on condition that the D. C. S. should fulfil all the obligations of the S. P. G.

Resolved, "That the Secretary be instructed to continue the payments to the places severally named in the above mentioned second list, at all times when he shall be certified that a clergyman is resident in the said place or places."

The action of the Block Sum Committee was confirmed.

J. W. Marling was appointed a member of the Block Sum Committee, vice H. Pryor resigned.

J. R. DeWolfe was appointed a member of the Block Sum Committee, vice A. M. Uniacke removed from the Diocese.

NOV. 19TH.—With reference to the memorial from Lunenburg, the "Quebec Scheme" Committee reported that the present position of the D. C. S. will not allow them to recommend a grant toward supporting a clergyman as proposed. The Committee also drew attention to the fact that for the last two years the Parish of Lunenburg omitted to make any return to the general funds of the Society.

The recommendation of the Committee was adopted.

Attention was also drawn to the fact that no return had been made for the last year from St. Margaret's Bay.

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
