### THINKS REQUEST FOR INCREASE MEANS UNWILLINGNESS TO WORK

Chairman of School Board Gives Opinion on Teachers' Applications.

That a request for salary increase from the city teachers should be equivalent to a resignation in future was the suggestion made by Hon. H. A. McKewen, chairman, at last night's meeting of the Board of School Trustees. G. H. Green approved the suggestion and thought a resolution to that effect should be passed at once. No action was taken, however. A request that the board appoint Captain D. V. Palin, Cadet leader, as physical instructor for the city schools at a salary of about \$800 to supplement a salary received as Cadet officer, was brought before the meeting by a delegation from the Board of Governors of the St. John Cadet Battalion. The trustees promised consideration.

Hon. H. A. McKewen, the chairman, presided at the meeting. Others present were Trustees H. Colby Smith, A. A. McIntyre, E. R. V. Ingraham, G. H. Green and Thomas Nagle, S. A. Worrell, acting superintendent, and A. Gordon Leavitt, secretary.

A delegation of the Board of Governors of the St. John Battalion of Cadets, consisting of Colonel A. B. Snow, Major William Vassie, M.C., and Major G. W. Oland was admitted. Major Vassie, as spokesman, explained that the Cadet battalion was in process of formation and the co-operation of the school board was desired. The Government provided funds for uniforms, but not the uniforms and some recompense for the training officer, Captain D. V. Palin. The battalion board had provided funds for a band and hoped to provide uniforms. It was asking the board to appoint Captain Palin as supervisor of physical instruction in the city schools, as the local Cadet instructor was remunerated about \$800 to supplement the Government grant for Cadet training. Delegation was assured that the matter would receive consideration.

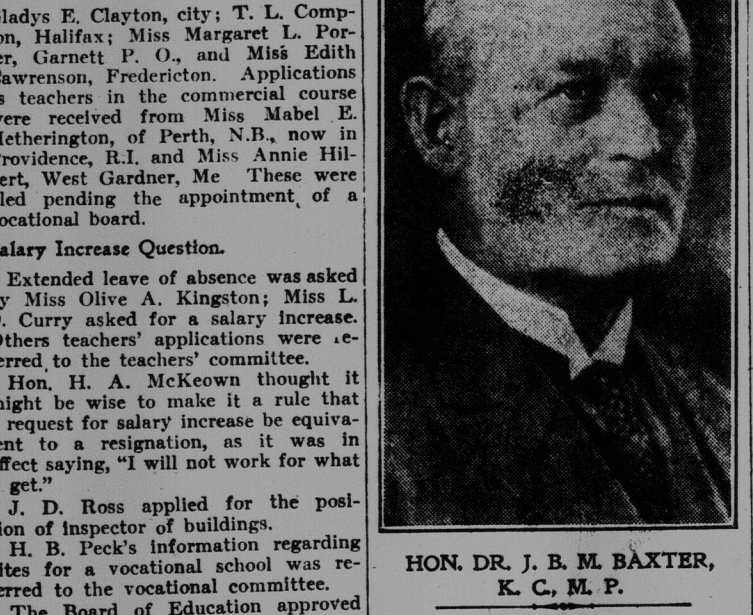
