For all practical purposes the scrap metal market does not exist at the present time. Toronto dealers admit that prices, quoted are simply nominal, and only represent the comparative value when placed against the metal in ingots. They will not pay the prices quoted. That seems quite certain, neither will they name other prices because there are no deals going through on which to base the new figures. Montreal goes one better and places the figures much lower this week. The situation is not likely to improve for some time to come. Prices of steel plate and sheets came down again during the week. There are large shipments of boiler tubes coming now, and the new lists will show a downward revision of from five to ten per cent.

There is nothing to indicate that there There is nothing to indicate that there is going to be any sharp decline in the price of steel. In fact everything is against it. The American situation at present, on account of fully 80 per cent of our steel being imported, finds a quick response in the Canadian situation. At U. S. points war prices for labor are still in vogue, and indications do not point to any considerable dropping in prices of finished goods.
