

KING'S BENCH JUDGMENT

In the case of Colwell vs Corbett in the King's Bench Division of the Supreme Court this morning Chief Justice McKeown set aside a judgment entered by the plaintiff against the defendant for the sum of about \$2,000. In this case a specially endorsed writhad been issued and had been allowed to go to judgment before question as to its validity was raised. Objection was taken that the statement of claim included interest on money paid. The court found that there had been nothing of a contractual nature for payment of interest, such as a bill of exchange or written instrument and declared a special endorsement on the writ improper. This rendered the judgment a nullity. An order will be taken out within a few days to bring the case before the court for a hearing. G. H. V. Belyea, K.C., appeared for the plaintiff and J. S. Tait for the defendant. Costs were ordered against the defendant no matter which party, succeeded.
