REMARKS.

CATHEDRAL.—Full services on all holydays and service on Sunday at Jail.
 ST. MATTHEW'S.—235 Communicants on Easter day.
 270 Volumes in parochial library.
 Full services on all the great holy days of the church and twice a week during Lent and Advent.
 The Holy Communion is administered twice a month, and on all days in accordance with the Rubric.
 ST. PETER'S.—Divine service twice a week during Lent and Advent.
 240 Volumes in parochial library.
 ST. MICHAEL'S.—Services on the principal Festivals of the church.
 Religious instruction given twice a week at the school, and a weekly Bible Class in the evening.
 TRINITY CHURCH.—Services on the principal Festivals and during Lent.
 MONTMORENCI.—Service on all the great Festivals.
 PORTNEUF.—Service on Christmas day and Good Friday.
 RIVER DU LOUP, (en haut.)—Children catechised in the church.
 The Missionary serves two stations in addition in the Diocese of Montreal.
 FRAMPTON.—The children receive religious instruction in the day schools and are publicly catechised in the church.
 POINT-LEVIS.—Service every Wednesday in Lent, and on the principal Festivals.
 HOPETOWN.—The £50 paid by the Mission is in store orders, and at store prices, there being very little money in the place, the people generally being very poor.
 DANVILLE.—Service on the chief holy days of the church.
 The church accommodation does not include the school houses in Tingwick, Windsor and Brompton.

ST. PAUL'S.—Service on Christmas and Good Friday.
 Made 150 visits to Marine Hospital. 33 Services in Chapel.
 MALBAIE, GASPE.—In the 75 families enumerated, many Norwegian families are not included, although I have baptized, married and buried some of these people.
 A good day school much wanted. People very poor.
 DURHAM.—Rev. S. S. Wood. Services performed at Acton, Three Rivers, Hatley, Marbelton and Melbourne.
