In a canteen stock room, and 2 chaps sleep in the canteen bldg. There was no evidence of the place having been broken into. IN THE OPINION OF THE COURT IT IS UNNECESSARY TO COMPLY WITH RP 83(B). D131313 Cpl ROBINSON NE, 22 CSEC, having been duly sworn states: I recognize the accused, and on 1 Apr I was NCO ic of the canteen at 22 CSEC. The accused was employed in the canteen as volunteer for bringing in the coal and water, during Feb and Mar and later. He also helped me clean up the dishes and helped to bring water. We had a stock room behind where we served, Did the accused have access to the stock? Q. He was behind the counter cleaning the cups. A. Did you check the inventory on 31 Mar? I believe I did. We made an inventory once a month. One also we made the next day and we were short a lot of things, among which A. One also was were razor blades and cigarette lighters. Looking at Exhibit "A" what do you say with mef to your deficiencies? Everything in Exhibit "A" is what we had in the canteen sir. How do the quantities compare with your deficiencies? Q. Very well, sir. A . CROSS EXAMINED Do you know all of the stock they carry in the canteen? Yes. A . Q. Can you swear that everything you see in that box was once in the "Y"? No, there is a bottle of shaving cream there that wasn't in the "Y". A . Everything else though we had. Have you got any definite mark to recognize any of those articles? A . No. Q. Do you drink? A . Yes. Heavy? A. Did you drink sometimes while on duty? A. No. Did you have a watch in repair in Mar? Q. Yes, in the camp electrician's place. A. Did you pay him some money?
