CONVERSATIONAL.

ABOARD.

B H J—Will you come aboard?
B H P—Do you wish me to come aboard?

ACCIDENT.

B H S—Have you met with an accident?
B H W—We have met with an accident.
B J H—We are aground.
B J P—The accident is serious.
B J S—The accident is not serious.

ANCHOR.

B J W—Where shall we anchor?
B P H—Do you wish to anchor before dark?
B P J—We wish to anchor before dark.
B P S—Anchor near us.
B P W—Is the anchorage good?
B S H—The anchorage is bad; do not come to.

SHORE.

B S J—Keep near the shore.
B S P—Keep clear of the shore.

ASHORE.

B S W—Are you going ashore?
B W H—We are going ashore.
