CURIOUS MODE OF BARTER. At Temenhint, in Northern Africa, the inhabitants have a curious mode of barter. The person who has any goods to sell mentions what he viakes to exchange for certain commodities, whether oil, liquid, butter, or shahm, which is a kind of salted fat, much resem-bling bad tallow in taste and smell. If liquids, h-pours water into a pol, in proportion to the quantity of oil or butter he requires: if solid, he brings a stone of the size of the shahm or other article demand-stones until he thinks a fair equivalent is offered, the quantities then agreed for are made up to the size of the stone or the depth of the water.
